Effectively develop, evaluate and provide feedback to players. Other tasks as agreed between the Parties on a case-by-case basis. Comply with HYC FC risk-assessments for events and activity for under-18s and where HYC FC directly employs or deploys under-18 referees, coaches and volunteers to ensure that appropriate safeguards are in place. Support messaging so that under-18s in youth and open-age adult grassroots football know how to report concerns about their wellbeing. Listen to and consult with under-18s on their experiences of grassroots football. Provide the highest level of customer excellence to players and parents. Contribute to ensuring that safeguarding and equality are embedded throughout HYC FC and grassroots football. To contribute to the effective implementation of The FA's Safeguarding Operating Standard for County FAs.
