Responsibilities

- The setting up, delivery, management and reviewing of football coaching for the benefit of children/young people enrolled at HYC FC through delivery of coaching sessions
- Where applicable, preparing for matches and providing a coaching/management function during these matches.
- Effectively develop, evaluate and provide feedback to players.
- Other tasks as agreed between the Parties on a case-by-case basis.
- Comply with HYC FC risk-assessments for events and activity for under-18s and where HYC FC directly employs or deploys under-18 referees, coaches and volunteers to ensure that appropriate safeguards are in place.
- Support messaging so that under-18s in youth and open-age adult grassroots football know how to report concerns about their wellbeing.
- Listen to and consult with under-18s on their experiences of grassroots football.
- Provide the highest level of customer excellence to players and parents.
- Contribute to ensuring that safeguarding and equality are embedded throughout HYC FC and grassroots football.
- To contribute to the effective implementation of The FA's Safeguarding Operating Standard for County FAs.
- To comply with HYC FC and FA rules, regulations, policies, procedures and guidance that are in place from time to time.
